

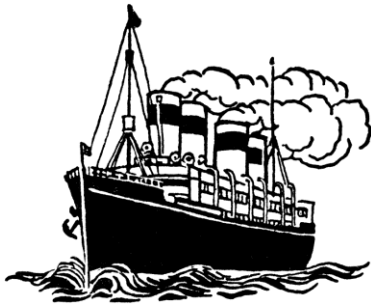

CLASS 1 – VISIT TO THE MARITIME MUSEUM AT FALMOUTH on WEDNESDAY 15TH MAY

As part of our topic of 'Under the Sea', Class 1 will be visiting the Maritime Museum in Falmouth.



During this visit, the children will take part in an educational workshop where they will learn about making boats and floating and sinking. We will also meet Oceana, a mischievous Cornish sea sprite, who collects treasures from the seabed and brings them to the museum. The children will learn a magical rhyme to wake her up to come and play. In the afternoon, we will have some time to explore the museum.

Please could the children come to school wearing their usual school uniform with sensible walking shoes and a waterproof coat if it is raining.
