As a school we continue to develop learning strategies and collaborations to help us deliver a high quality and modern curriculum. A large part of this involves using online tools to support our pupils learning and to increase communication with parents and family at home.

To aid with this we would like to extend our photo permissions. You may remember at the very beginning of your time at Penpol you signed a form to allow us to use photos of your children on our school website, in local media and for our own records. Today we are asking to extend this permission slightly to encompass using images and video in other online services too.

These services would be carefully selected and vetted to ensure the benefit to learning is paramount (and in line with our Safeguarding policy). We may also look to include other online services in the future to support learning and to promote the school.

Therefore we are asking for permission to use photos and videos on **external websites**, as well as our own school website. As with our current policy you can be assured that we will never use full names in conjunction with photos on public websites.

We are really excited about the possibilities that digital learning and connecting with other classrooms around the world can offer and hope that you feel able to give consent to enable us to continue to expand and broaden our curriculum in this way.
