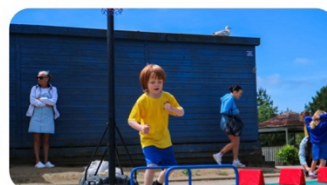
Have you recently **changed your address or phone number?** Please do update your details at the office as soon as possible. Thank you.
